

# North Dakota Space Grant Consortium Scholarship Program



## Goals:

To identify, recruit, and retain students in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics;  
To encourage women and underrepresented students to enter these fields of study; and  
To increase NASA activities and awareness in North Dakota

## Eligibility:

Applicants must be citizens of the United States who are enrolled in an undergraduate program at a tribal or public two-year or four-year institution of higher education in North Dakota. The degree program should be in the areas of science, technology, engineering, or mathematics.

## Description of Undergraduate Scholarships:

Undergraduate scholarships will be awarded each school year. The amount of money available for scholarships varies by college. The Office of Financial Aid at each college will determine the number of scholarships awarded and the due date for applications for each school year. Scholarship awards are limited to \$2,500 each per student. Students at UND and NDSU are not eligible for these scholarships.

Primary selection criteria are:

- 1) Academic excellence (a minimum GPA of 3.00 is required)
- 2) Relevance of the student's discipline and interests to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics

## Application Procedure:

Applicants should submit the following to their respective Office of Financial Aid:

- 1) Completed application form - available from Office of Financial Aid or online at: <https://ndspacegrant.und.edu/scholarships/undergraduate.html>
- 2) Letter of recommendation from at least one faculty member.
- 3) **Only Lake Region State College students:** Please submit a one-page essay about yourself and your current and future educational goals and how they are related to this scholarship. Deadline is **Friday, November 15, 2019**.
- 4) **Only Minot State University students:** application deadline is **October 31, 2019**.
